Once upon a time...

The story of Peter Pan, created by JM Barrie, follows the adventures of a mischievous boy who can fly and refuses to grow up, an illuminated trail now exists that allows audiences to follow Peter's adventures, and is available to tour.

Departure for Neverland

In Edwardian London, Peter Pan visits the nursery of the Darling family to listen to Mrs. Darling's bedtime stories. After his shadow is captured by the family dog, Nana, Peter returns one night with his fairy companion, Tinkerbell, to retrieve it. He awakens the eldest daughter, Wendy, who sews his shadow back on. Peter then convinces Wendy and her brothers, John and Michael, to fly away with him to Neverland, a magical island where children never age.

Life in Neverland

Upon arrival, the Darlings meet the Lost Boys, a group of forgotten children for whom Wendy becomes a mother figure. Their time is filled with adventures involving mermaids, Native Americans, and the villainous Captain Hook. Hook seeks revenge on Peter for cutting off his hand and feeding it to a crocodile, which now follows the pirate, ticking with the clock it swallowed.

The Final Battle and Return

The conflict peaks when Captain Hook kidnaps the Darlings and the Lost Boys while Peter is away. Peter rescues them, defeating Hook in a final duel that ends with the pirate being chased away (or consumed) by the crocodile.

Upon leaving the lamps, visitors are welcomed by Nana the dog, whose cozy kennel is nearby for her to take a break when needed. Nana, depicted as a puppet, engages directly with the audience along the trail, necessitating an area to effectively handle a stationary crowd.



Here, ethereal projections of mermaids dance around, while enchanting mermaid lamps guide the way beneath the gentle sway of jellyfish. As hazy bubbles fill the air, audiences are fully enveloped in a magical underwater experience, deepening the sense of wonder as they explore this aquatic paradise.

Crocodile Creek features a striking centerpiece: an animatronic crocodile positioned amidst a captivating array of clocks, varying in size from large to small, creating a magnificent display in sheer numbers. This remarkable creature has its mouth perpetually opening and closing, seamlessly integrated into the enchanting landscape.

Internally illuminated clocks are expertly programmed, to ring throughout the entire installation, enhancing the immersive experience for all who visit.

The grand finale of the trail should, where space permits, feature the majestic galleon alongside its equally formidable captain, Captain Hook.

This iconic galleon can be designed as either a one-sided or two-sided installation, depending on the specific location, which must have crane access for proper rigging.

Enhancing the experience, an actor will be present to engage with the audience as they stroll by, adding a layer of interaction to the spectacle. In situations where space is limited, we are creatively exploring innovative methods to position Hook on the galleon, ensuring that the magic of this encounter remains captivating for all.








IMAGE: Mermaid Lamps in the Lagoon
